

WHAT TO DO BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT

- Do NOT wear eye makeup. Makeup close to the eye must be removed prior to the application process. Use a mild, oil free cleanser. Do not use oil based makeup removers.
- Do NOT apply face creams or sun block to the eye area. The oils in many moisturizers/sunblock pre vent eyelash adhesives from properly adhering to your natural eyelashes, drastically reducing the longevity of your eyelash extensions.
- Do NOT put on any mascara. Removing mascara takes a lot of time. We want to spend your time

working on perfecting your lashes.

- Do NOT curl your lashes before your appointment. Straight lashes work better with eyelash extensions.
- Shower prior to your appointment. Eliminating any unnecessary contact with water or steam within the first 24-48 hours will insure the bond between the extensions and your lashes has enough time to properly set.
- Contact lenses must be removed before the application process. If you wear contact lenses, wear glasses instead to your appointment of bring a lens case and remove them when you arrive to your appointment.
- We suggest that you bring your own music or audio book player. Please turn off your phone/ringtone during the procedure. Talking should be kept to a minimum because this procedure requires precision. This is truly a time to lay down and relax. Listen to your favorite audio or take a nap, and let the lash transformation begin.

HOW TO TAKE CARE OF YOUR LASH EXTENSIONS

Now that we have given you beautiful set of eyelash extensions, it is up to you to maintain them. Please follow these guidelines to help keep them looking beautiful longer.

- Be gentle with your new lashes. For the first 24 hours do NOT get them wet, do NOT touch them and do NOT rub them.
- · Avoid swimming, steam rooms, or hot saunas within the next 48 hours. Avoid extreme heat.
- Do NOT use eyelash curlers. Do NOT perm or tint the extended lashes. This will break the bond between the extensions and your eyelashes.
- Do NOT use oil-based products (No oil-based eye makeup, makeup removers, moisturizers, cleansers, and sunscreen) on or near your lashes. Oil-based products will dissolve the eyelash adhesive, dramatically reducing the longevity of your eyelash extensions. Be oil-free.
- Be very careful about how you remove your eye makeup. Use only non-oily, non-creamy cleansers/removers. When removing eye makeup, gently go over the area and always sweep up and away from the lash extensions.
- Do NOT use mascara. Mascara will dissolve the adhesive. If you absolutely must use mascara make sure it is not oil-based or waterproof, be sure it is water-based and do not apply it near the roots of your eyelashes.
- · Avoid rubbing your eyes. Do NOT rub your eyes too hard when cleaning your face. Avoid running water directly on your lashes.
- · Avoid sleeping face down to prevent from sleeping on your lash extensions.
- Do NOT pull on any loose extensions, you'll risk pulling out your real eyelashes. Do NOT attempt to remove the lash extensions yourself. Let them fall off naturally or come back and have us remove them professionally with a special eyelash extension remover.
- Keep an eyelash comb handy to straighten up any loose/stray lashes. Comb them carefully and very gently only when needed. Avoid combing more than once a day.
- Resist playing with or touching your lashes. The golden rule is: look, but don't touch. The less you touch them, the longer they will last.
